Subject: Florida Southeast Connection, LLC Docket No. PF14-2-000 Florida Southeast Connection Pipeline Monthly Pre-Filing Status Report

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Florida Southeast Connection, LLC ("FSC") hereby files this Monthly Status Report for the Florida Southeast Connection Pipeline ("Project") for activities conducted from February 1, 2014 to February 28, 2014.

Project Scope and Schedule

No changes in the FERC project scope or schedule have occurred since the submittal of the Monthly Pre-Filing Status Report on February 4, 2014. FSC also continues to examine minor route adjustments to the proposed route as additional survey and stakeholder information is received. In addition, an alternative location for crossing the Kissimmee River on the north side of State Road 60 is currently being investigated. The updated Resource Report 10 will include descriptions and a table outlining modifications to the proposed pipeline route.

Environmental & Cultural Resource Surveys

Environmental and cultural resource field surveys have been completed on 82% of the proposed route. The remaining 18% of the proposed route were surveyed via desktop analysis due to lack of property access. FSC land agents continue to communicate with landowners to arrange for environmental and cultural surveys on the remainder of the route. In the last month survey access has been granted on 11% of the remaining 18% of the route that has not been field surveyed. Field surveys of these areas will be conducted in the coming months.

Agency Consultation

Representatives of FSC met recently with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, Florida Department of Transportation, Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP"), US Army Corps of Engineers ("USACE"), and US Environmental Protection Agency. The attached stakeholder meeting list provides the dates and summaries of those meetings that have occurred during February 2014.

State and Federal Permits and Clearances

The FDEP Environmental Resource Permit and USACE Section 404 Permit applications will be submitted on Friday, March 7, 2014.

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Landowners

FSC continues to make notifications to landowners as the proposed route, alternative routes, and access roads are updated. FSC is actively working with individual landowners to address their concerns regarding routing on their property as access is granted. The following list summarizes the status of survey activities to date:

- Survey Permissions:
 - o 726 Tracts in Survey Corridor
 - 0 87% Tracts Granted Access for Environmental Surveys
 - o 93% of Route Granted Access for Environmental Surveys

Public Outreach

FSC's outreach team will continue its efforts to keep the public and community leaders in the project area informed of Project activities. Included in these efforts for February was updating the FSC website with the latest project information including safety information and the FERC's NOI. In addition, Project presentations were made this month to the Sierra Club, Rotary Club of Okeechobee, Okeechobee County Commissioners, Economic Council of Okeechobee Board, Florida Audubon, and Indiantown Chamber of Commerce Board. These presentations are shown on the updated stakeholder meetings list.

FSC received one public comment filed in FERC Docket PF14-2 during February 2014. FSC staff has reached out to this individual and discussed his concerns regarding the proposed project.
